Purpose: To support girls 14-18 in their journey to earn the Girl Scout Gold Award, the

highest award in Girl Scouting.

Reports to: Director of Volunteer Services

Application: Gold Award Committee Application

Responsibly and Accountabilities:

- Must be a trained registered member of Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio in good standing.
- Be familiar with GSSGC's processes to achieving Gold.
- Review the proposed projects and make recommendations to ensure that it is, in fact, a
 measurable and sustainable project to earn the Girl Scout Gold Award.
- Approve project in a timely manner; if there are suggestions for change or community contact, they should be in writing.
- Assist with recognitions of Girl Scout Gold Awardees as requested. Attend awards gala.
- Promote Girl Scouting and the Girl Scout Gold Award to girls and the community.
- Attend Girl Scout Gold Award Committee monthly meetings.
- Contact your mentee within 3 business days of assignment and at least every 4 weeks after that. Once project is approved, check in every 6 weeks.
- Consider each project as individual. Avoid comparing projects with one another.
- Review the Girl Scout Gold Award Final Report and respond within 24 business hours to committee chair.
- Serve a 2 (two) year term, renewable by invitation upon satisfactory performance with a maximum of 3 terms.

Desired Skills: flexibility, creativity, patience, understanding, and ability to work well with girls ages 14-18.
