

Position:	DELEGATE/ALTERNATE DELEGATE
Accountable to:	Region Chair
Elected:	By a quorum of Members of each specific geographic area within a Region*
Objective:	Attend and represent the views of Girl Scouts in a specific geographic area within a Region at Delegate Meetings and the Council Annual Meeting

Responsibilities:

- 1. Adheres to Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio Council (GSSGC) Policies and Procedures for Volunteers; including the Council Affirmative Action Policies and BYLAWS of GSSGC.
- 2. Attend Delegate Training.
- 3. Attend and/or vote if a quorum* is present, at Special Meetings called by the Region Chair.

4. Attend and/or vote at GSSGC Annual Meeting if a quorum is present. The Annual Meeting quorum is defined as 25% of the members of the Council and provided that all of the Council's regions are represented by at least 1 delegate.

5. Distribute information on the proposed plans, policies, and other matters referred to the Region by the Board of Directors.

Qualifications:

1. Belief in the purpose and principles of Girl Scouting; knowledge of Girl Scout philosophy, policies and program.

- 2. Membership in good standing in Girl Scouts of the USA and GSSGC.
- 3. At least 14 years of age.
- 4. Adults: Volunteer Application, Volunteer Agreement and clear background check.

5. Willing and enthusiastic as a volunteer, with the ability to devote the necessary time and effort to complete the task

6. Represent the views of your geographic Region.

Training:

Training will be provided through GSSGC.

Commitment:

Elected by geographic region for a term of two (2) years for maximum of three (3) terms.

*The majority of the region's elected and appointed delegates or ten percent (10%) of the members of the region shall be present for the transaction of business.
