Position: Regional Events Chair

Reports to: Vice President of Member Services/Designee

Summary: Is responsible for collaborating on planning, implementing, and accomplishing Regional Events with the Area Event Coordinators as they execute event offerings at the community level that provide high-quality experiences for girls and adults that are aligned to the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

Term of appointment: The Regional Events Chair appointment is for a two-year term that is renewable upon satisfactory performance with a maximum of three terms.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in coordinating logistics and event details within designated region
- Sits as a voting member of the Regional Advisory Team; including attending monthly meetings
- Remain informed about and comply with the most current policies, procedures, and guidelines of Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio and Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA)
- Ensure events presented fall within the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE) guidelines
- Provide mentoring and support to Area Event Coordinators

Qualifications and core competencies:

- **Girl focus:** Empower girls to lead activities, learn by doing, and cooperate with others on current issues that involve their interests and needs, while having fun.
- **Personal integrity:** Demonstrate dependability, honesty, and credibility.
- **Adaptability:** Adjust, modify own behavior, and remain flexible and tolerant in response to changing situations and environments.
- Oral communication: Express ideas and facts clearly and accurately.
- **Foster diversity:** Understand, respect, and embrace differences.
- Computer skills: Access to E-mail and the Internet.
- Additional requirements:
 - Bilingual (if applicable)
 - o Must be a background cleared member in good standing of Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio
 - Complete required and ongoing training as required
