

Camp Packing List

Please use the following list of clothing and gear as a guideline. Some items your campers bring (or do not bring) will depend on individual habits. Your camper should bring enough clothing (including socks and underwear) to last the entire stay at camp. Camp Skyland Ranch is located 5000 feet above sea level in the San Jacinto Mountains near Idyllwild. The nights can be cold and the days can be hot so bring a camping sleeping bag and blanket. It is common to experience sporadic rainstorms throughout the summer season.

Packing Tips

- Make sure your camper knows what their luggage looks like and label all items with first and last name
- Pack light (campers are responsible for carrying their own belonging from the drop-off point to their cabins).
- Do not send/bring expensive or irreplaceable items to camp. (Girl Scouts of San Geronimo Council is not responsible for lost or broken items).
- Campers should do their own packing so they know what they brought and where it is located.
- Send/bring an empty bag for dirty clothes (labeled with name).
- Limit yourself to 2 **soft sided** bags (duffle & sleeping bag) **plus a backpack**

What To Bring

- ☐ Medication Record form (if bringing medication)
- ☐ bagged lunch for first day
- ☐ long pants
- ☐ shirts
- ☐ shorts
- ☐ warm pajamas
- ☐ sweat pants
- ☐ sweater or sweatshirt
- ☐ socks
- ☐ underwear
- ☐ warm jacket
- ☐ 1-2 pairs of tennis shoes (good traction & laces please)
- ☐ Mess Kit (knife, fork, spoon, plate, cup in a mesh bag)
- ☐ swim suit or shorts & t-shirt for water zone
 - old tennis shoes or water shoes to wear at water zones
- ☐ rain gear (plastic coat, poncho or rain suit)
- ☐ flashlight with extra batteries
- ☐ toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ hairbrush and/or comb
- ☐ ponytail holders
- ☐ shampoo/conditioner/soap
- ☐ sun block (SPF 15 or above)
- ☐ lotion
- ☐ lip balm (SPF 15 or above)
- ☐ towels
- ☐ wash cloth
- ☐ sanitary supplies (if applicable)
- ☐ deodorant
- ☐ water bottle, or canteen (should be leak proof)
- ☐ warm sleeping bag (no slumber bags)
- ☐ Backpack (school backpack/daypack)

Additional Items for Horse Units

- ☐ jeans (required)
- ☐ well-fitting gloves (optional)
- ☐ Western boots or shoes with at least a ½ inch heel with smooth soles (There is a limited supply of boots available to borrow at camp.)

Optional:

- ☐ pillow
- ☐ blanket
- ☐ Sheet to cover mattress
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ books/magazines
- ☐ Item to tie dye (we provide a bandana)
- ☐ hat or cap with brim (for sun protection)
- ☐ bandana or large scarf
- ☐ stationary, postcards, stamps, and pencil/pen

Items Not Allowed at Camp - Any items found at camp will be given to the Camp Director to store and will be returned to parent/guardian during check-out:

- Sandals or open-toed shoes (except if for shower shoes)
- Halter, tube, crop tops, or any top with an exposed midriff or bra
- Electronics including: MP3's, iPods, radios, CD, DVD, game devices, or computers
- Glass containers
- Aerosol cans or spray bottles (including sunscreen/bug spray)
- Money
- Nail polish or polish remover
- Pocket knives, firearms, or other weapons
- Gum, candy, or food items from home unless pre-arranged
- Personal sports equipment
- Pets (will be required to pick up pet)
