

In an effort to provide all participants and staff with a safe, fun, positive experience, the following guidelines must be followed. Review this information with your camper to make sure they have a clear understanding of each guideline. These guidelines will be included in your camper's digital forms and require an acknowledgment from both the camper and parent/guardian.

For Campers

1. I will try to be sensitive to the needs of the other participants and staff by performing my assigned duties, including, but not limited to, unit Kapers, all-camp Kapers, and participating in camp activities.
2. I will be responsible for my own health; eating meals, getting enough sleep, taking my medication (if applicable) and notifying the camp staff if I do not feel well, need additional or different food to eat, or I suspect a health problem.
3. I will do my best to live up to the principles expressed in the Girl Scout Promise and Law. I will respect the people and places I come into contact with.
4. I will contribute to the camp community by sharing my ideas and participating in discussions and planning.
5. I will be responsible for my personal belongings and equipment.
6. I will listen carefully to all orientations and will observe all safety precautions for all activities. This includes transportation to and from camp.
7. I will use all safety equipment provided to me for use in activities. I will treat the equipment provided for me with care.
8. I understand that the use of drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco products will not be tolerated and that the usage of any will result in immediate expulsion from the program.
9. I understand that weapons of any kind are not allowed in camp. This includes but is not limited to fire arms, knives and explosives. Possession of any of these will result in immediate expulsion from the program.
10. I understand that profane language and threatening other campers and staff will not be tolerated and that the usage of any can result in immediate expulsion from the program.
11. I understand that if I do not abide by these guidelines, my parent/guardian will be contacted. This could result in expulsion from the program. I also understand that if I am sent home early due to misconduct, I will not receive a refund of the fees paid.

For Parents/Guardians

12. I understand that in the event I am more than fifteen (15) minutes late picking up my child on the last day, I will be charged \$50 (fifty dollars) per hour (or any increment of the hour) for child care costs.

13. I agree that I will not send with my camper any items on the “items not allowed at camp” list.

14. I agree that should my camper need to be removed from the program for any reason, it is my responsibility to, either myself or a delegate, retrieve her within 4 hours.

15. I agree to not send a cell phone to camp with my camper unless turned in to health staff during check-in or otherwise arranged with the Camp Director.

16. I agree that, in the event of an emergency, I will call the camp emergency line (909)748-7229 to be connected with my camper.
