FAMILY CHECKLIST

- Go online to complete the Parent Permission Form and review the Product Sales Program Rules before you pick up any cookies. After receiving your initial cookie supply, you should plan to turn in 50% of money due before picking up more cookies from the troop.
- Keep receipts for any time you receive, exchange, or return cookies with the troop cookie coordinator.

I-Care Program

What is I-Care?

I care is a Girl Scout community service opportunity where customers purchase cookies to be donated. Since your customers have chosen to donate the cookies, their purchase is tax deductible. Cookies are donated to the Military, local food banks and other community organizations.

How to participate:

Ask every customer to make an I-Care Donation

Collect \$6.00 for each package of I-Care purchased

Record each donation on your cookie order card in the "Donate Cookie Packages" column.

Give donation receipt to each customer who requests one. Downloadable receipts are located at gssgc.org under Cookies+

Turn in I Care money to your Troop Cookie Coordinator.

Goal setting is just 1 of 5 essential skills a Girl Scout develops through the Cookie Program. **Do you know the rest?**



Girls set cookie sales goals and, with their team, create a plan to reach them. This matters because girls need to know how to set and reach goals to succeed in school, on the job, and in life.



Decision Making

Girls decide where and when to sell cookies, how to market their sale, and what to do with their earnings. This matters because girls must make many decisions, big and small, in their lives. Learning this skill helps them make good ones.



Money Management

Girls develop a budget, take cookie orders, and handle customers' money. This matters because girls need to know how to handle money-from their lunch money to their allowance to (someday) their paycheck.



Girls learn how to talk (and listen!) to their customers, as well as how to work as a team with other girls. This matters because it helps them do better in school (on group projects, on sports teams, and on the playground) and, later, at work.



Business Ethics

Girls act honestly and responsibly during every step of the cookie sale. This matters because employers want to hire ethical employees—and the world needs ethical leaders in every field.

Subsidized Shipping Available 2/1/24-3/17/24

Digital Cookie's Minimum order for shipping is four packages. The base shipping price is 4-8 packages at \$12.99 and 9-12 packages at \$14.99

There is a \$5.00 surcharge on orders shipping to Hawaii, Alaska, Puerto Rico, APO/FPO/DPO, Guam and US Virgin Islands

Digital Cookie is an app and online site Girl Scouts use to manage their business—things like setting goals, tracking progress, reaching customers—they can even share and print their sales QR code. Plus, take credit card payments too (PS-cash and checks are also accepted.)

Check out these steps to get started!

CREATE YOUR SITE & DOWNLOAD THE APP:

You'll receive an email by January 14th from Digital Cookie (digitalcookie.girlscouts.org). Click the link in the email to register your Girl Scout's account in the site. Add email@email.girlscouts.org to your safe sender's list so you don't miss the email. In the email is a pink "Register Now" button. Simply click on that button to be taken to the Digital Cookie platform. You'll create a password and use it to log in. You'll watch a safety video, then must accept the terms & conditions for the site. Once you've completed this initial set up, you can download the Digital Cookie app on your mobile device so your Girl Scout is ready to take credit card payments on the go.

SET UP YOUR SITE & REVIEW THE DASHBOARD:

To help your Girl Scout set up their business for customers, click on Site Setup to get started. Once the site is approved and published, your Girl Scout's online cookie business is up and running! Once you've begun marketing to customers, you'll be able to track sales, view orders (including orders to approve for Girl Scout delivery) and view progress to your troop's sales goal.

- Offline sales: Cash or check purchases made by customers and recorded in Digital Cookie.
- Online sales by Delivery: Online purchases made by customers from your cookie site for donations, shipped cookies, deliver in person, or cookies in hand sales paid through your mobile app.

DID YOU KNOW?

Girl Scouts that use online sales tools like Digital Cookie in combination with traditional sales sell more packages on average and reach their goals faster.

Decide on your cookie delivery type

Decide on your cookie delivery type: There are two ways customers can receive cookies when they order online: by shipping cookies directly to their home (with shipping fees) OR delivered by the Girl Scout and their caregiver (Girl Scout delivery). In Digital Cookie, you'll have the option to activate Girl Scout delivery when setting up the site. You can also inactivate this option at any time during the season.

Share your cookie site vand/or send marketing emails

Starting January 14, cookie site links can be shared by social media, text, or email. Marketing emails can be sent directly to family and friends. To access your cookie site link, go to your Digital Cookie account and find it on your homepage under My Cookie Site:

*Cookie site links may not be shared to Facebook Marketplace, eBay, Craigslist, or any garage sale site. Girl Scouts and families engaged in online cookie sales must always follow the Digital Sales & Social Media policy.

Review and approve orders from Digital Cookie

When orders come in for Girl Scout delivery, you must approve the orders in Digital Cookie within five days. Go to the Orders tab to view all orders that need approval. You'll see a list of all orders, the customer's info, and the number of packages in the order. You'll receive a reminder email each day if you have orders that haven't been approved in the system.



HELPFUL TIPS:



If you are out of a cookie variety for Girl Scout delivery, you can turn off the variety in the Digital Cookie site. Go to the My Cookies tab and switch the cookie variety to "off" then click on update delivery settings. You can turn delivery back to "on" once you get additional inventory.



Digital Cookie features resources to help you if you get stuck, like tip sheets, videos, and a Help section built right into the site.

My Cookies Tab: Tracking Your Inventory

Digital Cookie can help make sure that you have enough cookies for your orders, track your progress on delivering/selling offline orders and/or make sure your record of cookies received from the troop matches what has been given to your Girl Scout.

To learn more, go to your My Cookies tab:



The top part of the dashboard shows the total number of packages that have been transferred to your Girl Scout from the troop. It can include booth sales and troop sales. It is not the same number of cookies you are financially responsible for.



The inventory section gives you a quick view of how many cookies you should still have undelivered and how many you may need to fill your Girl Scout delivery orders. The first thing to note is **My Offline Sales.** Offline sales need to be updated by you or your Girl Scout when cookie sales are made in-person with cash or check payment. Click on the down arrow to enter this information and click on **Save Updates** to save changes.



Get to know your inventory totals: There are three sections that calculate your inventory. Click on the arrow next to the total # of packages to show you information by variety.

1: Current inventory: The Received number comes from the total packages transferred to you by the troop. The Delivered number will reflect your offline sales & any sales made using the mobile app using the *Give Cookies to Customer Now* feature, and any Girl Scout delivery orders that have been delivered & marked delivered in the Orders tab.

2. Pending Delivery/To Approve: This section shows you how many cookies you need to fill Girl Scout delivery orders you have approved and those you have yet to approve.

3. Inventory Needed: This section will show you any packages of cookies needed to fill your orders. The totals indicated here will be accurate if you track your offline sales in Digital Cookie.

Remember, it may take your troop coordinator time to enter transactions, so please be patient if you have received cookies from the troop that need to be entered.

Scroll down to the **Financials** section to help you view the amount due for cookies and how the troop is calculating the amount. **Online Paid** totals reflect online payments for Girl Scout delivery orders, donation, or Cookies in Hand orders. **Offline Paid** totals are the payments received by cash or check that you have given the troop volunteer and they have credited to your Girl Scout. **Total Balance Due** totals the difference from the amount owed for your inventory and the amount paid to the troop.





How to Support Your Troop

Participate in Troop Booths

Customers look forward each year to Girl Scouts selling at the stores they visit. Each troop has the opportunity to participate in Troop Booths. Troops can do as little, or as much as they would like based on availability.

How do Troop Booths Work?

- 1. Troop Booths are scheduled in Smart Cookies by the Troop Coordinator.
- 2. Girls must be in Girl Scout attire. Girls should be recognizable in their Girl Scout uniform wearing their vest/sash and GS Membership pin.
- Do not use the shopping carts to store cookies. Carts may be used, where permitted, to transport cookies to and from the booth only.
- 4. Do not use the store trash bins. Bring your own trash bags.
- 5. Cookies must always be at least 6 inches off the ground in a cart, wagon, table etc.
- 6. Two Girls and two adults are required to be present at all times, unless the Girl Scout is a Senior or Ambassador who participate in the 1:1 or 2:1 booth requirements.
- 7. One of the adults at the booth are required to complete booth training and have a current Adult Membership with GSSGC. We encourage both attending adults to have current membership for liability purposes.
- 8. If for any reason, you cannot show up for your scheduled booth times, please contact your Troop Cookie Coordinator ASAP.

More Basics

Your Troop Cookie Coordinator is a <u>Volunteer</u> and needs your help to deliver a fun and successful cookie program to the troop.

What you need to know: Your troop coordinator can help answer questions about upcoming deadlines. They will also provide you with cookies to fulfill your Digital Cookie orders and cookies for Walkabout. They will also be able to let you know the status on money owed and your Girl Scout's progress toward her goals.

You are personally financially responsible for all cookies ordered and received by your Girl Scout and all money collected from customers.

Caregivers and Troop Cookie Coordinators should sign a receipt for all money turned in and cookies picked up.

Caregivers should turn in all payments to the Troop Cookie Coordinators by the given deadlines.

Any lost or stolen money is the responsibility of the caregiver who signed the girl's parent responsibility form.
